IMPORT ANALYSIS

PRETZELS

I. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Import Analysis is one of a series prepared in order to assist businesses and other organizations in their market research of specific products. The detailed import information provided in these reports supports studies by organizations seeking to expand existing production lines, change individual product characteristics or engage in new manufacturing investment in Canada. The coverage of an import analysis is developed in close consultation with the client, and is tailored to meet those specific requirements. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of competing in a particular market.

This analysis of imports of pretzels is based on a detailed examination of Revenue Canada Customs import documents for the period July 1986 to June 1987. Imports classified to the following Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) import commodity code were analysed: 064-55-10 Pretzels



II. IMPORT TRENDS - 1983 TO 1987

Between 1983 and 1987 the value of pretzel imports increased from \$2.5 million in 1983 to \$3.5 million in 1987 (an average annual growth rate of 8.4 per cent), despite a decrease of 7.1 per cent from 1986 to 1987.



III. ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

Imports of pretzels as shown in this report during the period July 1986 to June 1987 were valued at \$3.1 million with a quantity of 3.9 million lbs. or 1.8 million kg.

III. ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS (CONT'D)

Imports of pretzels, stick type, amounted to a value of \$1.5 million or 49 per cent of the total imported value. Twist type pretzels amounted to \$658 000 or 22 per cent. A further value of \$836 000 or 27 per cent was not identified by type.


The overall average unit price, of all types of pretzels as shown in this report was \$1.71 per kilogram. There was very little fluctuation of average unit price between the various types of pretzels. Twist type pretzels were the most expensive, averaging \$1.78 per kilogram. Stick type and ring type pretzels averaged \$1.67 and \$1.69 per kilogram, respectively. For further details showing type, package size and average unit price refer to Appendix A.

Shipments of pretzels were imported in both consumer type packages and bulk containers. The consumer type packages amounted to \$2.1 million or 68 per cent of the total value of imports. Bulk containers amounted to \$706 000 or 23 per cent. The remaining imports did not indicate package size on the Customs documents.

The most popular consumer type package size was 200 grams, amounting to \$1.0 million or slightly over 50 per cent of all consumer type packages. They averaged \$1.77 per kilogram. Bulk containers with sizes of 2.3 kg. and 3.2 kg. combined for a total of \$308 000 or 43 per cent of the imports of bulk containers. They averaged \$1.33 per kilogram. For further details by package size and price range refer to Appendix C.

Imports originating from the United States accounted for \$2.9 million or 96 per cent of the value of imports. The Federal Republic of Germany and Israel accounted for the remaining \$125 000 or 4 per cent.

Ontario was the major province of consignee for the imports of pretzels, with \$1.3 million or 42 per cent of the total dollar value. British Columbia followed with \$704 000 or 23 per cent. For further details by type, and province of consignee, refer to Appendix B.
