<u>Method</u>

The information presented in this report is more detailed than that generally available from Statistics Canada Mor Mother publications. Data which might reveal information about individual importers is aggregated.

Dollar values shown in this report are based on selling price F.O.B. plant, in Canadian dollars. This selling price represents the value paid by the importer, excluding all freight, packing and insurance costs when specified. All trade discounts, when applicable, are also deducted from the selling price.

IMPORT ANALYSIS

SODIUM SULPHITE CHEMICALS

I. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Import Analysis is one of a series prepared in order to assist businesses and other organizations in their market research of specific products. The detailed import information provided in these reports supports studies by organizations seeking to expand existing production lines, change individual product characteristics or engage in new manufacturing investment in Canada. The coverage of an import analysis is developed in close consultation with the client, and is tailored to meet those specific requirements. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of competing in a particular market.

This analysis of imports of sodium sulphite chemicals and ammonium thiosulphate is based on a detailed examination of Revenue Canada Customs import documents for the period July to December 1987. The following Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) import commodity codes were analysed:

403-58-10 Sodium Sulphite 403-59-21 Sodium Bisulphite 403-59-22 Sodium Metabisulphite 403-59-30 Ammonium Thiosulphate

Not included in this analysis are (C.I.T.C.) import commodity codes 403-59-29 Metallic Sulphites, not elsewhere specified (n.e.s.) and 403-56-20 Sodium hydrosulphite.

Total figures in this analysis do not correspond to those published by Statistics Canada. The differences are explained in Appendix H.

Note: The remainder of this report deals with the period July to December 1987.

III. ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

During the period July to December 1987 imports of sodium sulphite chemicals as analysed in this report amounted to \$2 677 725. The summary table below indicates that the majority of imports were sodium sulphite type accounting for 52 per cent of the dollar value. Most imports were of technical grade, rather than for food and photographic purposes. With respect to price, in the largest category of imports i.e. sodium sulphite, almost 50 per cent by value was imported at an average unit price of \$5.73. In the next largest category, sodium metabisulphite, an average unit price of \$22.09 dominated. By value, sodium sulphite and ammonium thiosulphate were primarily imported in bulk, while sodium metabisulphite was shipped predominantly in 50 and 55 lb. bags. Further details on imports by type, grade, price range and package size are shown in appendices A, B & C.



The United States was the dominant source of imports for sodium sulphite chemicals accounting for \$2.1 million or 78 per cent of the total dollar value. Other exporting countries, in descending order of value, accounting for the remaining 22 per cent were: Federal Republic of Germany, Japan, Poland, France, The United Kingdom and China.

Ontario was the major province of consignee, accounting for \$1.4 million or 52 per cent of the total import value, followed by Québec with \$1 million or 38 per cent, British Columbia with 5 per cent, and New Brunswick with 2 per cent. Other provinces, in order of value were: Alberta, Manitoba and Saskatchewan. (See imports by province of consignee, Appendix D).

There were 43 known consignees/importers of sodium sulphite chemicals during the period July to December 1987. The principal 15 consignees/importers accounted for \$2.4 million or 89 per cent of the total dollar value of imports. All consignees/importers are listed in alphabetical order in Appendix E.
