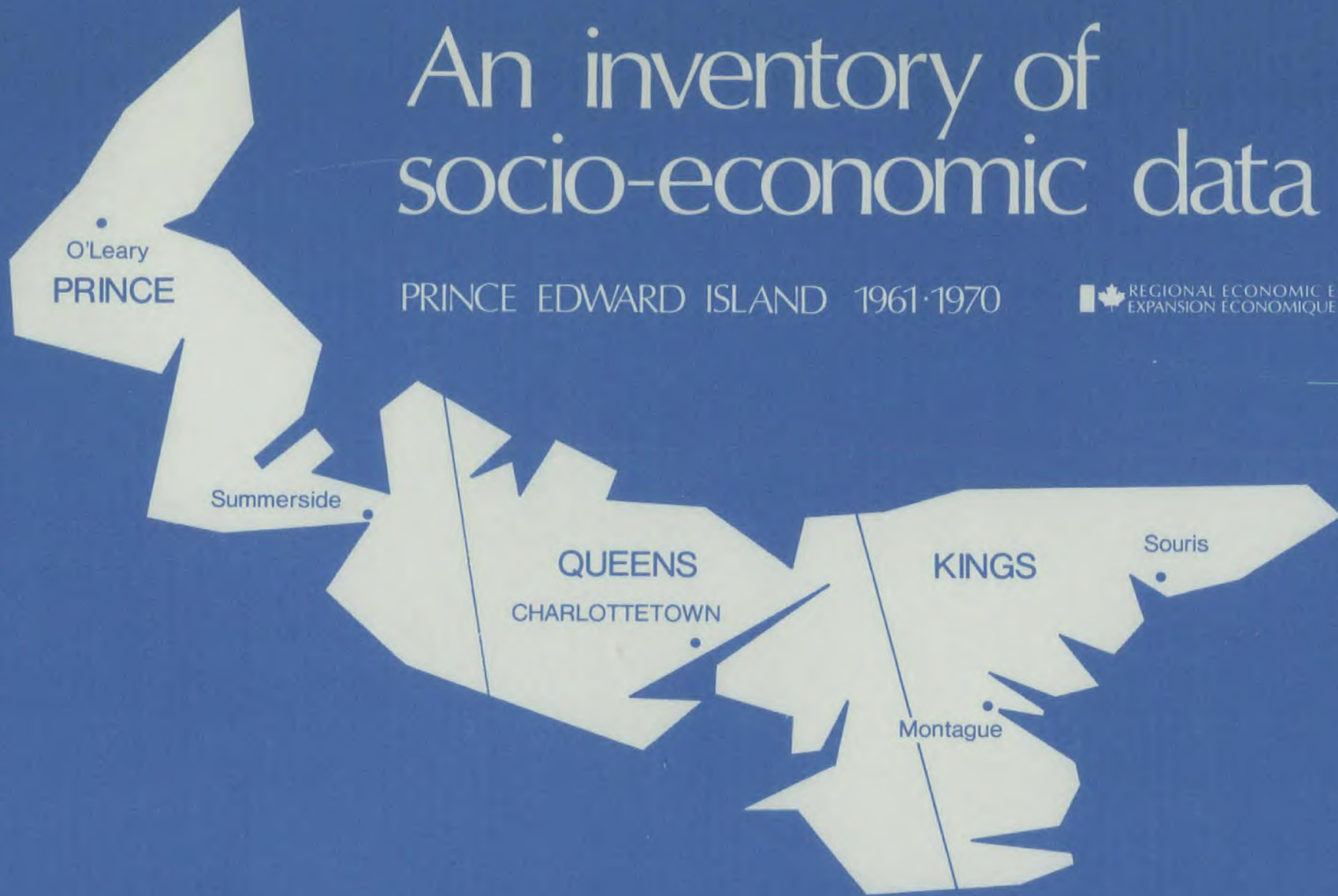

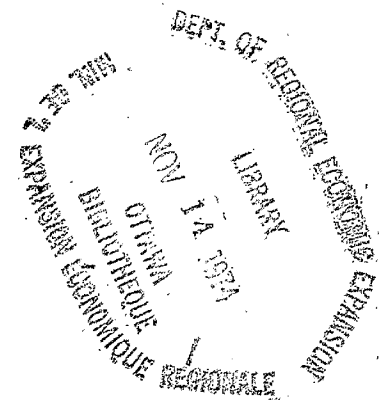

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FOREWORD

Undertaken by the Program Evaluation Branch of the Canada Department of Regional Economic Expansion with the cooperation and assistance of the Government of Prince Edward Island, the following inventory compilation was approved jointly by Canada and the Province under "The Development Plan for Prince Edward Island".

Presented whenever possible as a time series from 1961 - 1970, the data inventory is intended to give a statistical picture of all the important sectors of P.E.I. influenced by "The Plan". As data for the Atlantic Provinces and Canada are given in many instances, comparisons can be made among various regions of Canada.

The Inventory's uses are expected to be many. Those wishing to study the Island may use the data to measure the provincial economic and social environment discretely or they may choose to project the data to simulate baseline conditions. However, it should be recognized that since "The Development Plan for Prince Edward Island" is comprehensive in scope and is in fact designed to effect major revisions in the Island make-up, the trends apparent in the time series may well shift dramatically.

It is anticipated also that individual program and project managers of "The Plan" will use the data for management purposes. Implementors, armed with both trend patterns and actual figures, may be able to establish yardsticks with which to effectively gauge their own performance and formulate macro-goals for which to strive.

Continued updating of this document would be desirable if it is to retain its currency. We anticipate that this will be agreed to and will occur.

The data, compiled by Messrs. T. Brennan, R. Callaghan, J. Cronier, J. Gibson and T. Rankin under the supervision of M. Parnes was amassed during the three month period, June - August, 1971.

In 1966, 81 per cent of the boats were over 30 feet in length; in 1960 only 73 per cent were in this group. On the other hand, boats over 35 feet were 57 per cent of the total in 1966 but only 36 per cent of the total in 1960.

The above shows there has been a movement towards greater use of boats in the two largest size groups and a corresponding decline in the numbers between 20 and 35 feet in length. The total number of boats has fluctuated considerably, but there is no noticeable long term change in these figures.

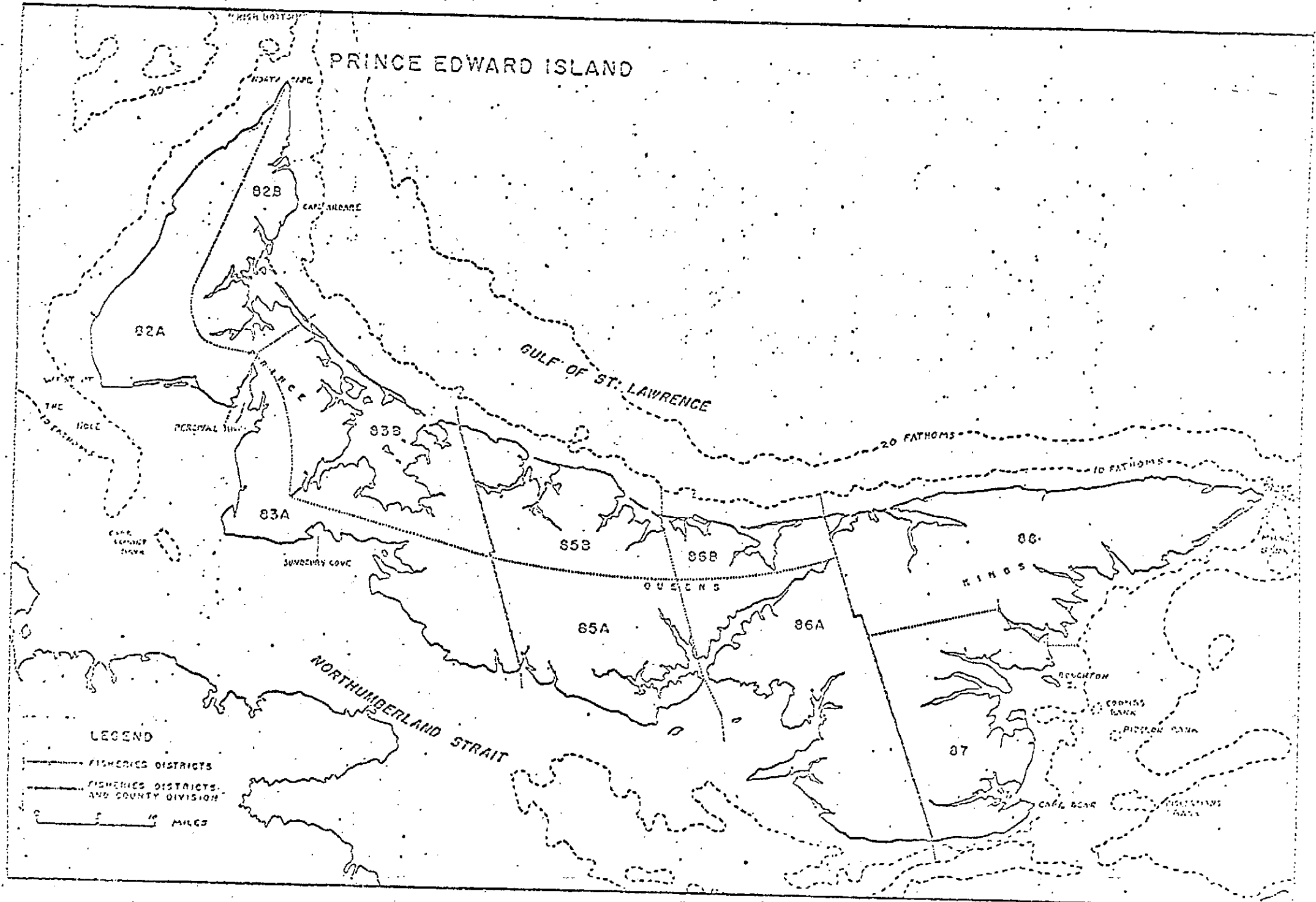

PROCESSING PLANTS

(1965)

Fish-processing establishments are located in approximately 300 communities in the Atlantic Provinces

In total these plants provide employment for approximately 11,000 people, 90 per cent employed in production functions and 10 per cent in service and management. During 1965, the average income per employee in fish-processing plants (from fish processing) was almost \$2,300, and ranged from a low of \$1,870 per employee in Prince Edward Island to \$2,650 in Nova Scotia (D.B.S., 1965). In New Brunswick and Newfoundland average fish-processing income was \$2,150 per employee.

At present there are approximately 520 fish-processing plants in the Atlantic Provinces. However, any observer examining these plants would probably classify at least half of them as improved fish houses or stores. According to information published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for 1965 there are 256 "establishments" in the Atlantic area. The principal statistics available for these establishments on a provincial basis are as follows.
