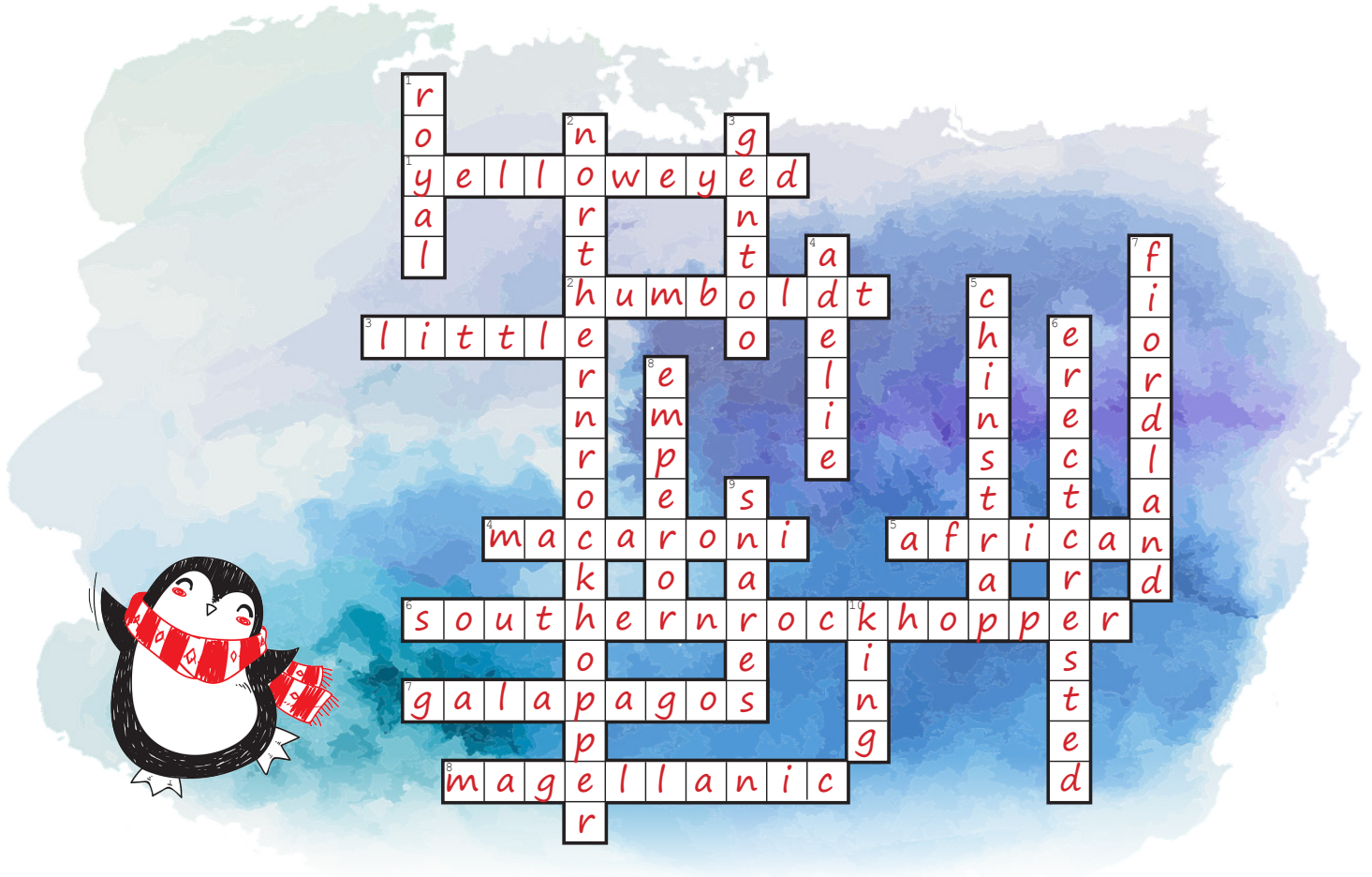


# CROSSWORD PUZZLE

## Down

- Lives primarily on Macquarie Island. *Royal penguin*
- The \_\_\_ are larger and have longer crest feathers than the Southern species (write without space).  
*Northern rockhopper penguin*
- Has a bright orange beak and white eye patches.  
*Gentoo penguin*
- Is named after the wife of Dumont d'Urville, the French Antarctic Explorer. *Adélie penguin*
- Has a narrow black band going from the chin to the cheek.  
*Chinstrap penguin*
- \_\_\_ are named for their crest of yellow plumes that are erect, or bristle up over their eyes (write without dashes).  
*Erect-crested penguin*
- The only crested penguin with white stripes on their cheeks. *Fiordland penguin*
- The largest of the penguin species. *Emperor penguin*
- Has bare pink skin at the base of its large red-brown bill.  
*Snares penguin*
- The closest relative to the largest penguin species.  
*King penguin*

## Across

- The largest penguin to breed on the mainland of New Zealand is the \_\_\_-\_\_\_ penguin (write without dashes).  
*Yellow-eyed penguin*
- This South American penguin's habitat is mostly along coastal Peru. *Humboldt penguin*
- The smallest species of penguin. *Little penguin*
- Its scientific name derived from Greek means "good diver with a golden crest". *Macaroni penguin*
- Has a distinctive pink patch above the eyes.  
*African penguin*
- Similar to its Northern counterpart, this penguin is smaller and has shorter spiky crests (write without space).  
*Southern rockhopper penguin*
- The only penguin found north of the equator.  
*Galapagos penguin*
- This penguin was named after a Portugese explorer.  
*Magellanic penguin*
