
CANDIDE MODEL 1.0 SERIES OF PROJECT PAPERS

The CANDIDE (CANadian Disaggregated Inter-Departmental Econometric) model is a large-scale, medium-term econometric model of the Canadian economy. This series of project papers describes CANDIDE Model 1.0 which was the initial focal point of the CANDIDE Project. In addition to serving as a description of some salient aspects of the Canadian economy, the model is intended to be useful for policy simulations and for conditional forecasts or projections. It is intended that information about the basic model be readily available to the government, business and academic communities, with the expectation that constructive criticism will be forthcoming to aid the Project staff in their developmental work.
