All sales are final. In the case of damaged, defective publications, or incorrect shipment, publications will be replaced if the claim is made within 7 days of receipt of publication. For subscriptions and standing orders, claims for missing issues must be made within 3 months of the release date for Canada and 6 months for subscribers outside Canada.

### Standing Order service

The standing order service applies to publications for which amendments are foreseen. When published, these amendments are automatically shipped to the customer and the cost (including shipping and handling fees), which can vary from one amendment to another, will be charged, no matter the number of copies purchased as long as they are shipped to the same address. The shipping and handling fees do not apply to the \$3.00 registration fee.

### **Co-published Publications**

Booksellers must order co-published titles directly from the co-publisher concerned, and not from the Canada Communication Group-Publishing, if they expect to receive a trade discount.

### To consult publications




