CANADA - ONTARIO GREAT LAKES SHORE DAMAGE SURVEY - COASTAL ZONE ATLAS

This atlas, which consists of 637 map sheets, colour-coded with aerial photographs, shows details on shoreline damage, ownership (federal, provincial, municipal, private), value, land use, physical characteristics and existing protective works in damaged areas. The data given is the result of a survey of the damage caused during the period November 1972 to November 1973 on the erodible portion of the Great Lakes from Port Severn on Georgian Bay to Gananoque on the eastern end of Lake Ontario, excluding the Niagara River.
