CANADIAN URBAN TRENDS - VOLUME 1: NATIONAL PERSPECTIVE (Copp Clark, Tor.)

Canada is both one of the most urban and one of the most rapidly urbanizing countries in the developed world. This handbook, which is the first volume of a series, provides the user with a set of tables, charts, maps and descriptive text outlining the social and economic ramifications of growing urbanization. It focuses on the 137 urban areas over 10,000 population in 1971, which accounted for 70% of Canada's population at that time. Individual chapters are concerned with urban population growth, the urban economy, manufacturing, income disparities, the family life cycle, the cultural mosaic, housing and patterns of interaction among urban areas.
