REPORT TO PARLIAMENT BY THE SUB-COMMITTEE ON THE PENITENTIARY SYSTEM IN CANADA

This report has received substantial media coverage since its tabling in the House of Commons. It will probably be referred to frequently for many years, not only by specialists in this area but also by the general public. It is a highly-readable and disturbing report, with a number of haunting black and white photographs, on existing conditions and attitudes in Canada's penitentiary system. Its message and significance are evident in its first recommendation contained in the preface: "A crisis exists in the Canadian penitentiary system. It can be met only by the immediate implementation of large scale reforms. It

is imperative that the Solicitor General act immediately on this Report as a matter of utmost urgency". The report contains 65 recommendations, numerous black and white photographs, and appendices. 202 pp. Separate French edition.
