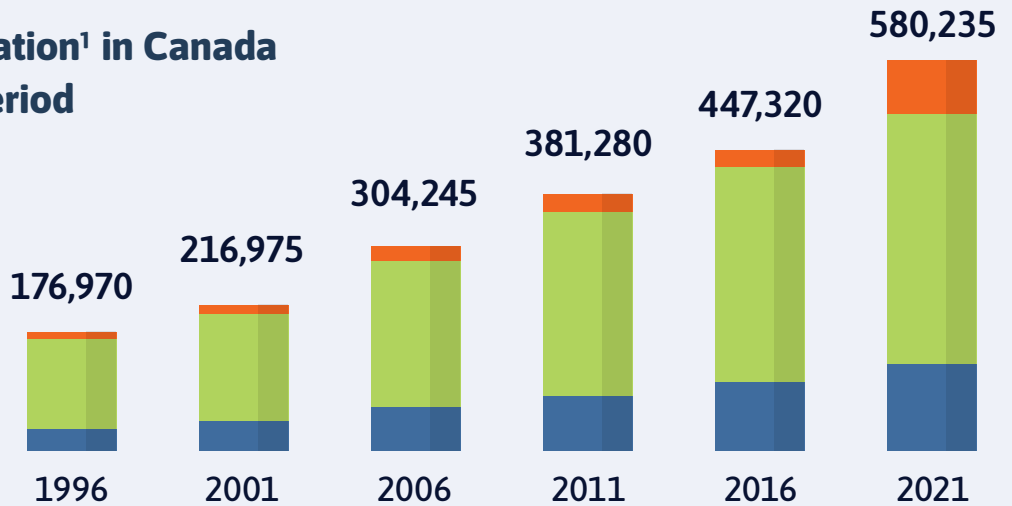


Latin American immigration to Canada

The Latin American population¹ in Canada tripled over the 25-year period from 1996 to 2021

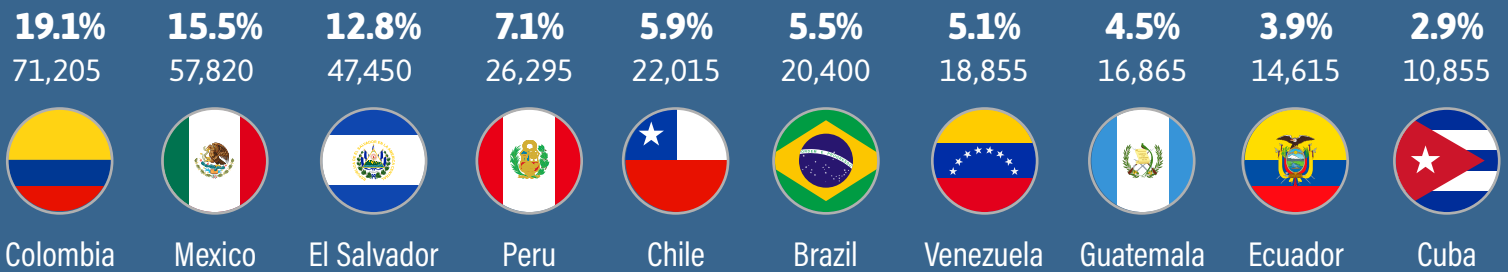
Size of the Latin American population, by immigration status, Canada, 1996 to 2021
