IN THE MINORITY OFFICIAL LANGUAGE IN CANADA, 2022


Government services

In 2022, **73%** of **English-speaking** adults in Quebec had, in the previous two years, **always or often** received services from the federal government in their language, compared with **42%** of **French-speaking** adults in Canada outside Quebec.

Services for immigrants

Among immigrants in the OLM population who arrived in Canada as adults and received assistance in one of the official languages to facilitate their integration into the community, **8 in 10** received it in the minority official language.
