The Transportation Safety Board of Canada (TSB) has launched a national safety issue investigation (SII) into **fires on commercial vessels** and **emergency response** in Canada. (M24A0348)

Why this matters

This **national-level** initiative aims at identifying systemic gaps in preparedness and response to vessel fires across the marine industry.

The SII will study:

- seafarer knowledge of fixed-fire suppression systems
- training in vessel-based fires for shore-based firefighting personnel
- the capacity to fight shipboard fires in Canadian waters
