

EXPORT AND IMPORT OF HAZARDOUS WASTES REGULATIONS (EIHWR)

The purpose of the EIHWR under the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999 is to set out the conditions to be followed prior to, during and after any export or import of hazardous wastes shipped across the Canadian border.

What are the goals of the EIHWR ?

- Promoting environmental responsibility among all of those concerned before, during, and after the international movement of hazardous waste. This environmental responsibility includes the transportation and handling of waste from the site of generation to the site of final disposal or recycling.
- Allowing governments of the countries of import, export, and transit to control which wastes enter or leave their respective countries.
- Ensuring that any transportation accident involving an international movement of hazardous waste will be cleaned up by requiring liability insurance coverage for exporters, importers and carriers.

Who is affected by the EIHWR ?

These Regulations affect all persons and organizations involved in the importation, exportation or transit of hazardous waste where Canada is one of the countries implicated in the movement. The EIHWR define the responsibilities of exporters (such as generators), importers (such as disposers/recyclers), and carriers.

What are the keys for exporting and importing hazardous waste?

KEY STEPS & EIHWR REQUIREMENTS

SEND ENVIRONMENT CANADA A COMPLETED AND SIGNED NOTICE INDICATING YOUR INTENT TO EXPORT OR IMPORT HAZARDOUS WASTES

Attach to your notice:

- the Canadian exporter or importer's liability insurance and carrier's insurance,
- a copy of the contract between the Canadian exporter or importer and the foreign generator or receiver.



OBTAIN ENVIRONMENT CANADA APPROVAL

No export, import or transit can be done without first obtaining a written confirmation from Environment Canada.



PROCEED WITH THE SHIPMENT

The following documents must accompany the shipment:

- the Canadian manifest with Parts A and B completed,
- a copy of the notice,
- a copy of the written confirmation.

The packaging, the labeling and the placarding must comply with the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations*.



ACCEPT THE SHIPMENT

- Complete Part C of the Canadian manifest.
- Send copies of the completed Canadian manifest to Environment Canada, to provincial authority and, if applicable, to foreign authorities.

DISPOSE OR RECYCLE THE HAZARDOUS WASTE

Submit a written confirmation to Environment Canada indicating that the waste has been disposed of or recycled.

Furthermore, a copy of this WRITTEN CONFIRMATION and the attachments named above must be deposited at the Canadian Customs Office, where the hazardous waste is required to be reported upon entry into Canada.

For all shipments for which this WRITTEN CONFIRMATION is being issued, you and the carrier or carriers of the hazardous wastes must be insured in accordance with section 9 or 14 of the EIHWR under CEPA. In the event that the current policy, or the one(s) of the carrier(s) expire(s) during the date period for which this WRITTEN CONFIRMATION is issued, you must submit immediately to this office a copy of the insurance renewal or a copy of the documentation to certify the issuance of a new policy.

We wish to remind you that the export or import of the hazardous wastes, in violation of the EIHWR, may be prosecuted as offences under paragraph 113(j) and section 116 of CEPA.




