## SECTION I

### SCOPE OF ANALYSIS

This report is a detailed analysis of "hobby" electric kilns during the period August to November 1980.

These products are normally included in Statistics Canada Import Class 505-79 "Other Industrial Ovens, Furnaces and Parts".

## SECTION II

### CANADIAN PRODUCTION

Statistics Canada does not provide data on production or shipments of "hobby" electric kilns, they do report that Canadian manufacturers shipments of industrial furnaces, kilns and ovens were valued at \$6,254,000 in 1978, the latest year available.

## SECTION III

### ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

Imports of "hobby" electric kilns during the period August to November 1980 amounted to 493 in number valued at \$182,091.
