

SECTION I

SCOPE OF ANALYSIS

This report presents an analysis of masonry/concrete and panelboard nails during the period January to March 1980. These products are normally included in the Statistics Canada Import Class 465-32 "Steel wire nails one inch or more in length".

SECTION II

CANADIAN PRODUCTION

Statistics Canada does not provide data on Canadian production or shipments of masonry/concrete and panelboard nails as such. They do provide shipment data for all types iron and steel wire nails. The latest years available are as follows.
