

SECTION I

SCOPE OF ANALYSIS

This report is based on a detailed analysis of imports of canned snails, canned pates (goose liver, pork liver and a combination of pork and goose liver) and canned turtle soup during the months of September, October and November 1978. These products are included in the following Statistics Canada Import Classes:

- 17-99(82) Meat pastes, canned, exc. poultry
- 17-99(89) Meat preparations, canned n.e.s.
- 46-99(23) Snails, canned
- 46-99(29) Shellfish and products, canned n.e.s.
- 141-59(50) Soups, canned, except infant foods
- 141-59(90) Soups n.e.s., soup mixes and bases

n.e.s. - not elsewhere specified

SECTION II

CANADIAN PRODUCTION

Statistics Canada does not provide separate data on Canadian production or shipments of the products included in this analysis.

SECTION III

ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

Canned Snails - Imports of canned snails during the period analyzed amounted to \$772,564. The analysis indicates that shipments originating from France amounted to \$459,414 or 59 per cent of the value, followed by shipments originating from Taiwan with a value of \$311,323 or 40 per cent of the value. Shipments with relatively high prices per ounce came largely from France; those with relatively low prices mostly from Taiwan.

Canned liver pates (Goose, pork and combination goose and pork)
Imports of canned liver pates during the period analyzed amounted to \$251,532. Pork liver pate amounted to \$130,882 or 52 per cent of the value followed by goose liver pate amounting to \$103,975 or 41 per cent of the value. Liver pates containing a combination of goose and pork accounted for the remaining \$16,675 or 7 per cent. All shipments originated from France.

Canned turtle soup - Imports of canned turtle soup during the period analyzed amounted to \$26,827. Shipments originated from various countries as shown below, with their corresponding percentages of the value: Switzerland (38%), United Kingdom (30%), West Germany (19%) and France (13%). Full details of the analysis are provided in the following table.
