SECTION I

SCOPE OF ANALYSIS

This report is based on a detailed examination of documents covering imports of ice making machines valued at \$10,000 and over included in Statistics Canada Import Commodity Code 655-66-10 "Ice makers".

Ice makers are manufactured in Canada, however, Statistics Canada does not provide separate data on production or shipments by Canadian manufacturers.

SECTION II

RECONCILIATION

The value reported by Statistics Canada's Commodity Code 655-66-10 is valued at \$7,045,000, the value analyzed by Import Analysis Directorate (IAD) is \$881,077 see table below.

SECTION III

ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

Imports of ice making machines valued at \$10,000 and over, during the period January to December 1980, amounted to \$881,077.

The analysis indicates that ice makers in the price range \$30,000 to \$85,000 accounted for over 66 per cent in terms of value.
