SECTION I

SCOPE OF ANALYSIS

This report is based on a detailed analysis of imports of red clay flower pots during the months of January to December 1980. This product is included in the following Statistics Canada Import Class: 867-99-69 "Flower pots, household, not elsewhere specified".

SECTION II

CANADIAN PRODUCTION

Red clay flower pots are presently being produced in Canada. However Statistics Canada does not provide separate data on Canadian production or shipments.

SECTION III

ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

Imports of red clay flower pots and saucers during the period January to December 1980 amounted to \$205,642. As noted in the analysis, Ontario is the primary province of entry accounting for 73 per cent of the total value, following by Quebec with 20 per cent and the remaining seven per cent entered into the Western provinces.
