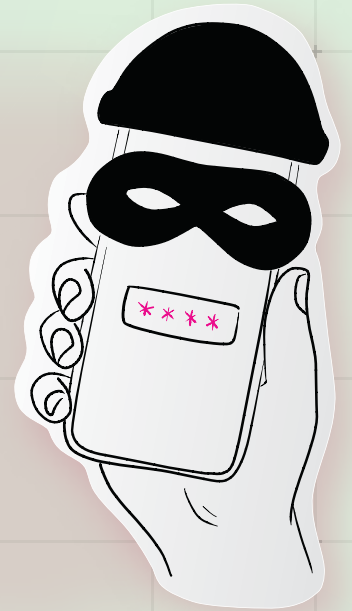

# cybercrime?



A crime can be considered a cybercrime when a computer or other digital technology plays an important role in committing a criminal offence. The *Criminal Code* of Canada outlines the law around these types of crimes:

### Section 430 (1.1)

Adam watches a friend enter their username and password. Later, Adam logs into their account and deletes several messages.



### Section 342.1

Natalie downloads software that will allow her to log into her girlfriend's laptop, but she has not used it yet.



### Section 184

Leah sets her phone to record audio and leaves it in a room with her friends without their knowledge. She later listens to their private conversation.



### Section 342.2

Andrew reprograms phones so that they can be used to hack into other devices. He sells them to his tech savvy friends.
