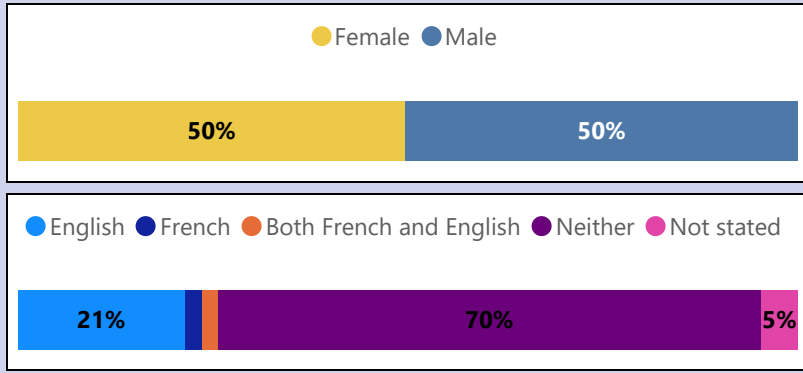

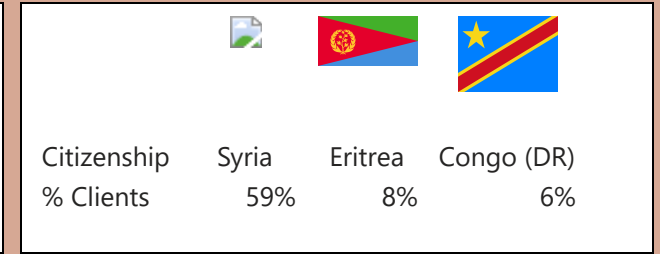
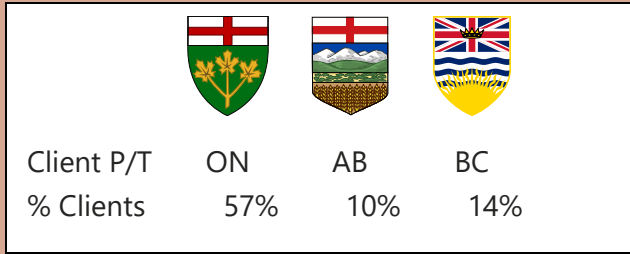


Blended Sponsorship Refugees

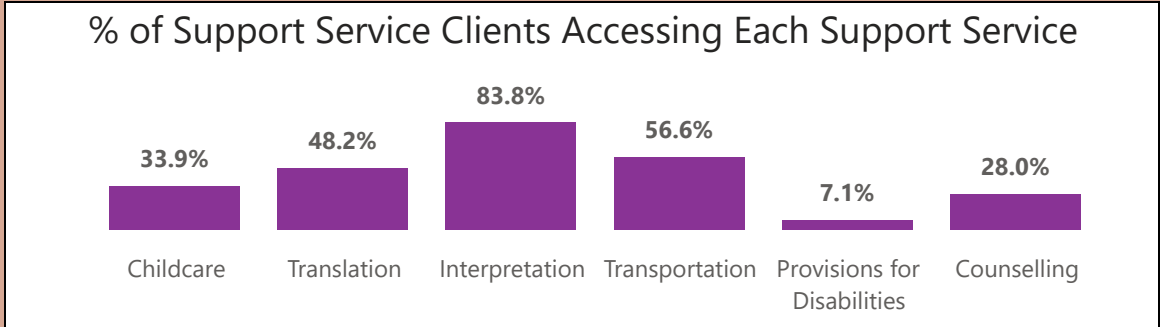

The Government of Canada provides 6 months of financial support, and private sponsors provide 6 months of financial support as well as 12 months of social, emotional, and settlement support.
