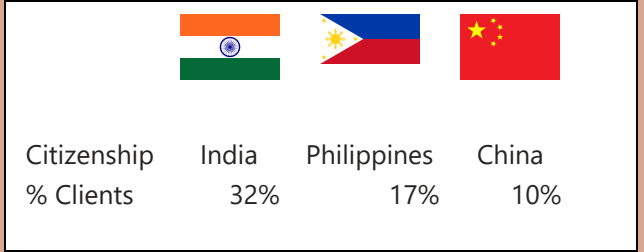
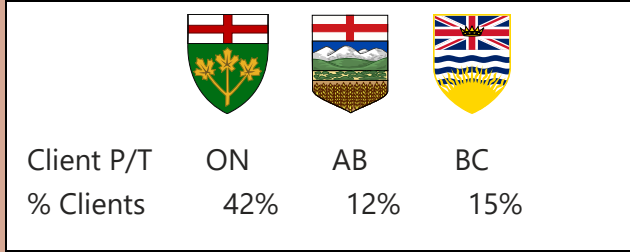


Economic Class Principal Applicants

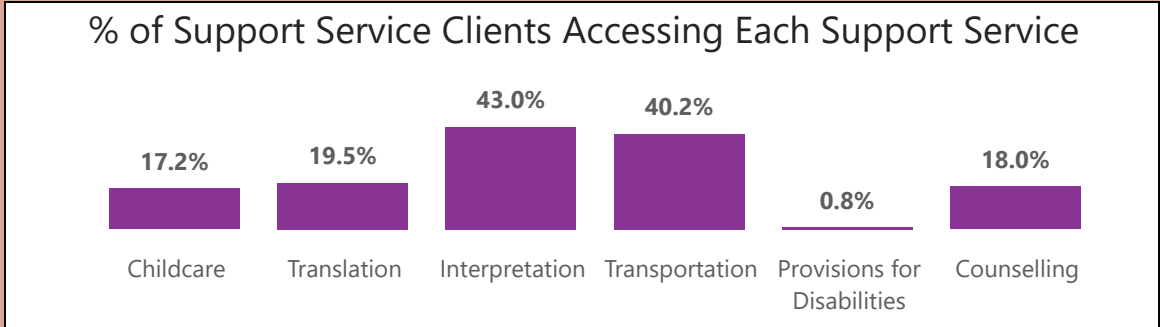

Economic Class immigrants include skilled workers, provincial and territorial nominees, business immigrants, Quebec skilled workers and Canadian Experience Class members. Principal applicants are selected on the basis of a points-based system that considers skills, work experience, language ability, education, and other factors.
