Economic Class Spouses and Dependants

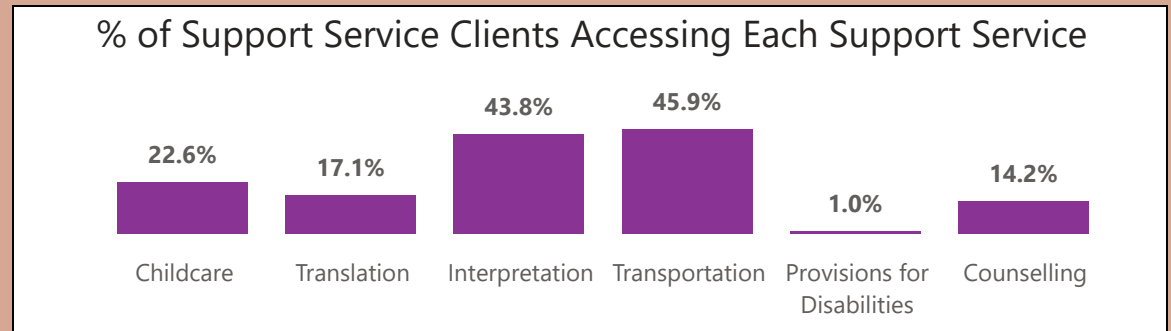

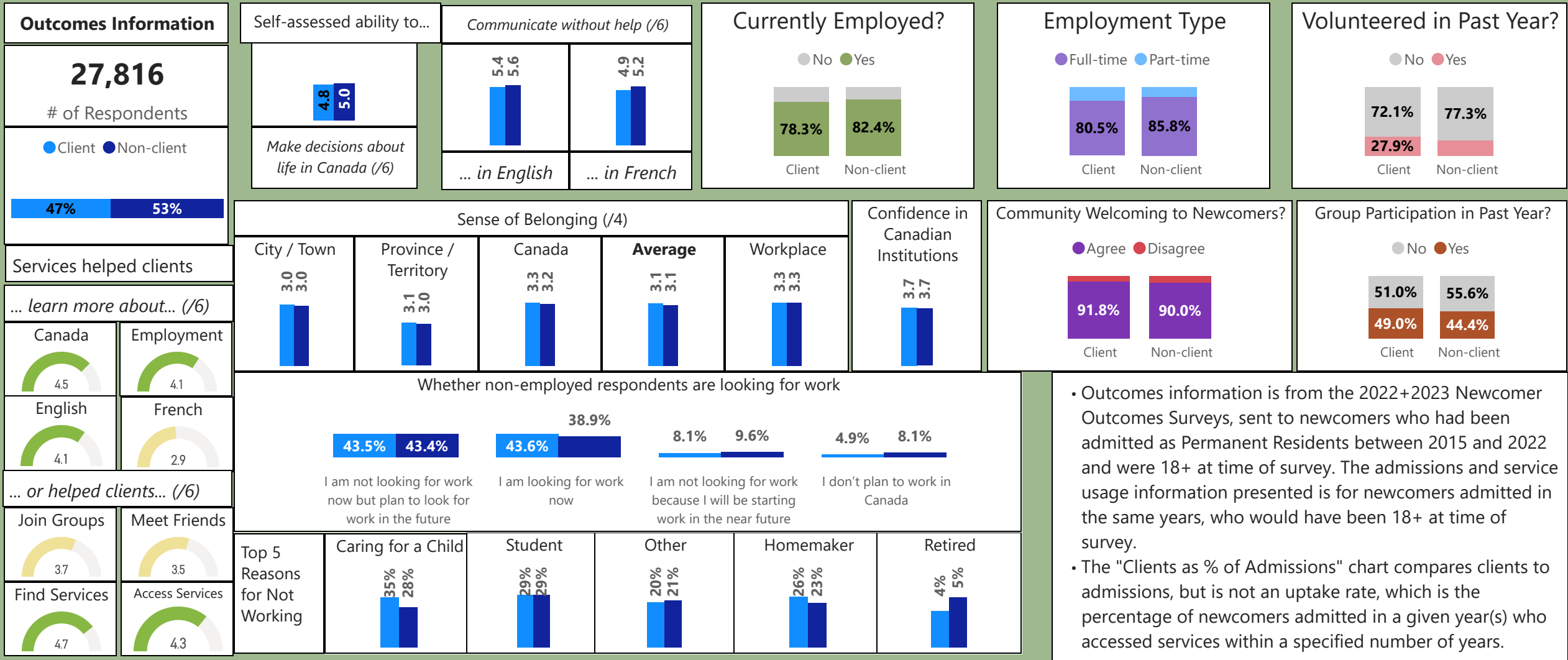

• Outcomes information is from the 2022+2023 Newcomer Outcomes Surveys, sent to newcomers who had been admitted as Permanent Residents between 2015 and 2022 and were 18+ at time of survey. The admissions and service usage information presented is for newcomers admitted in the same years, who would have been 18+ at time of survey.

• The "Clients as % of Admissions" chart compares clients to admissions, but is not an uptake rate, which is the percentage of newcomers admitted in a given year(s) who accessed services within a specified number of years.
