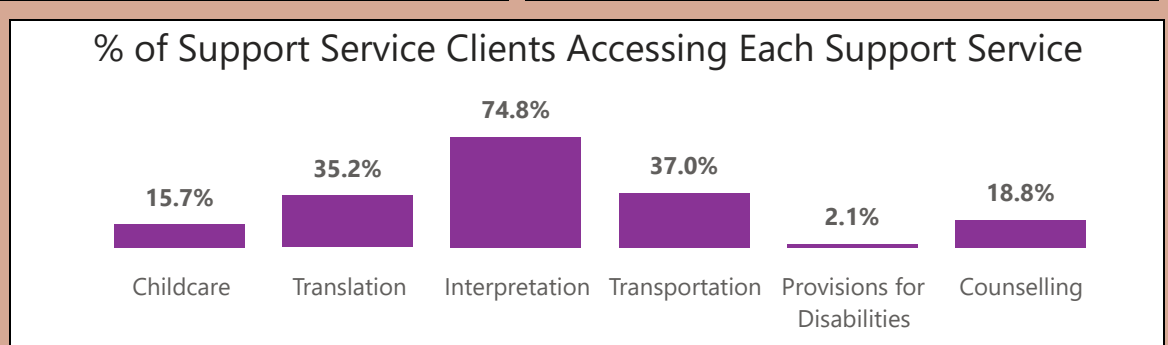

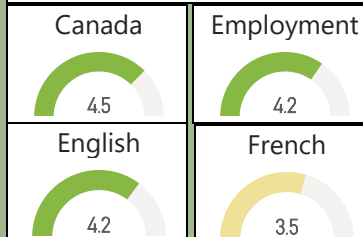

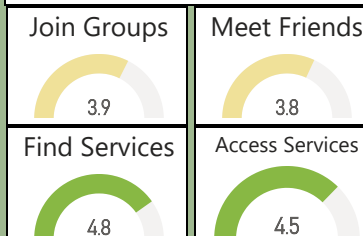

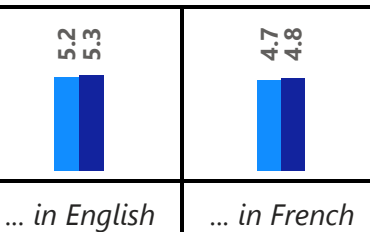

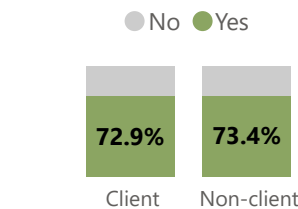

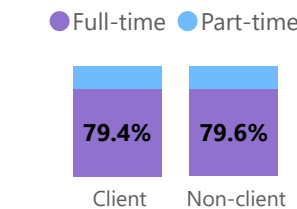

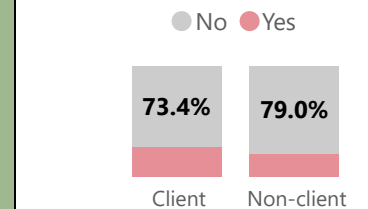
Currently Employed?



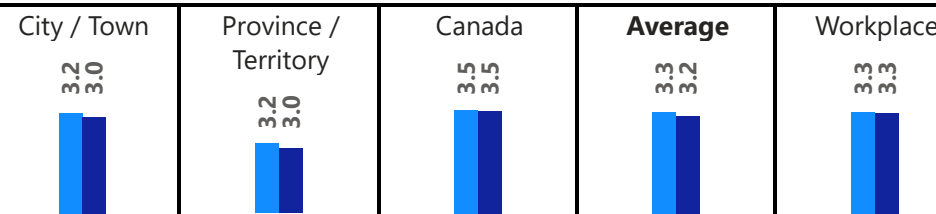
Employment Type



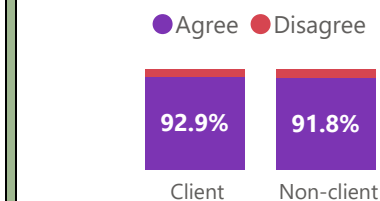
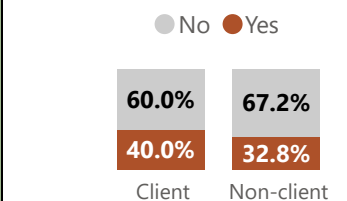

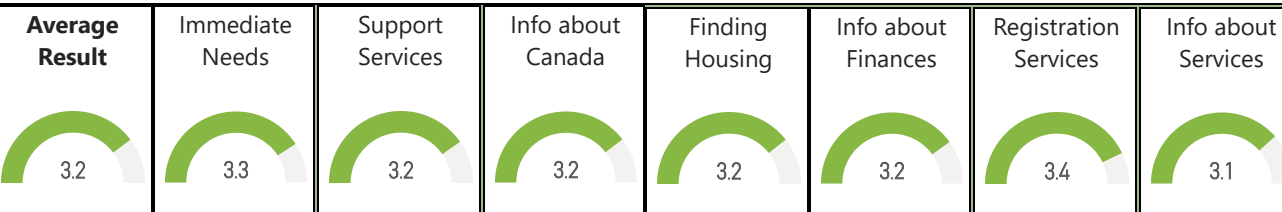

The admissions and service usage information presented is for newcomers admitted in the same years, who would have been 18+ at time of survey.
- The "Clients as % of Admissions" chart compares clients to admissions, but is not an uptake rate, which is the percentage of newcomers admitted in a given year(s) who accessed services within a specified number of years.
