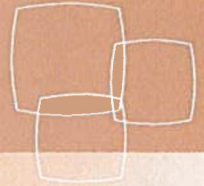

As of August 1, www.fightspam.gc.ca is live and offers information regarding Canada's anti-spam law, which was passed in December 2010 and is expected to enter into force later this year.

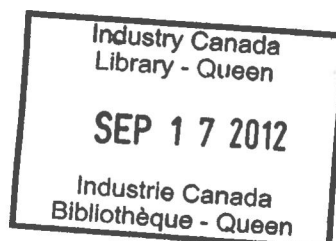

The new law will enable the Bureau to more effectively address false and misleading representations and deceptive marketing practices in the electronic marketplace, including false or misleading message headers and Web site content.

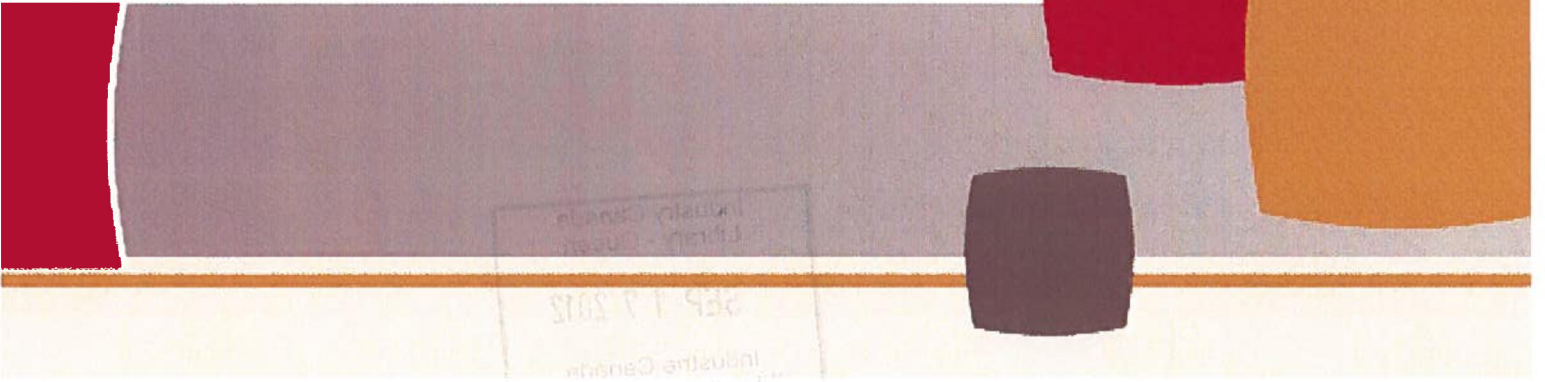
