Ontario Court of Appeal upholds \$500,000 penalty for deceptive marketing scheme

The Ontario Court of Appeal has upheld an Ontario Superior Court of Justice decision ordering an individual to pay a \$500,000 administrative monetary penalty in connection with a deceptive marketing scheme.

The Court [dismissed the appeal](#) of Steve Green, who had challenged the amount of the penalty he was ordered to pay in March 2012. The Ontario Superior Court of Justice had previously found that a total of three individuals and five companies had breached the Competition Act by engaging in a deceptive marketing scheme.
