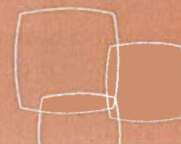

Competition Bureau Launches Whistleblowing Initiative

At the Canadian Bar Association's 2013 Competition Law Spring Forum, John Pecman, Interim Commissioner of Competition, [announced](#) the launch of the Competition Bureau's whistleblowing initiative, encouraging the general public and business community to report suspected incidences of price-fixing, bid-rigging, and other anti-competitive activity.

The identity of whistleblowers will be kept confidential, and the amount of personal information provided is up to the individual.
