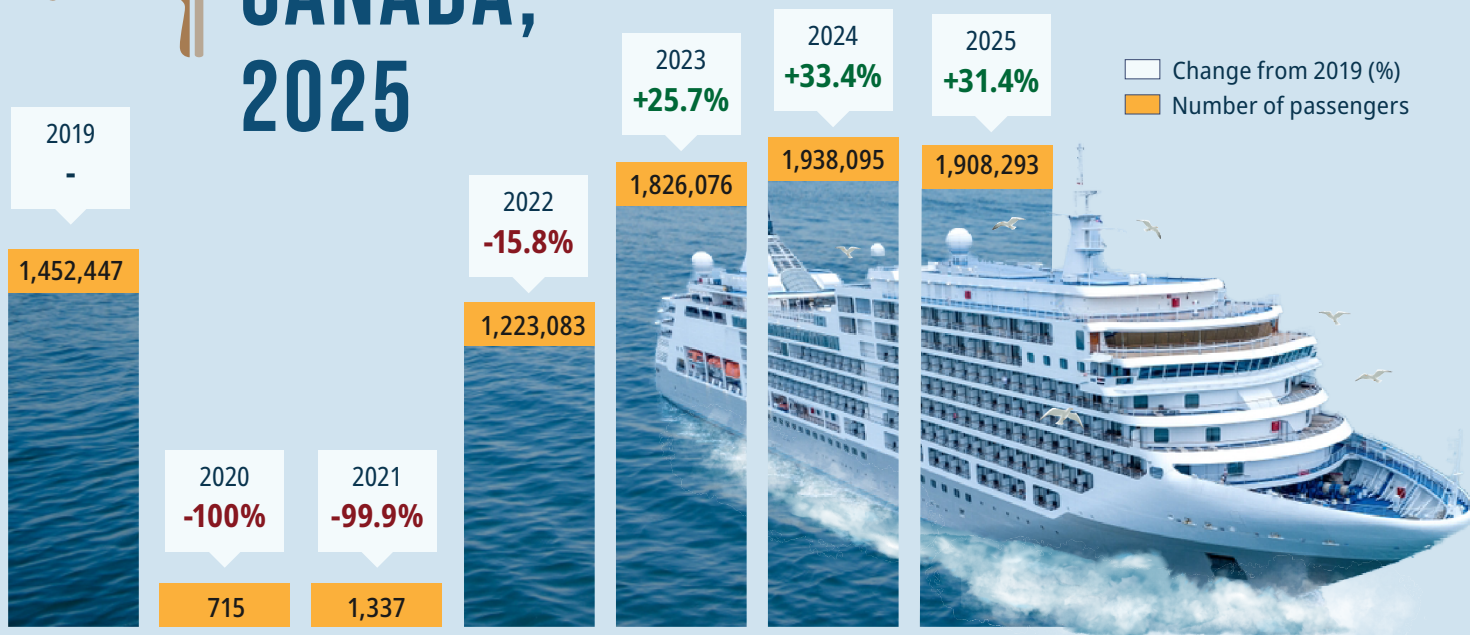
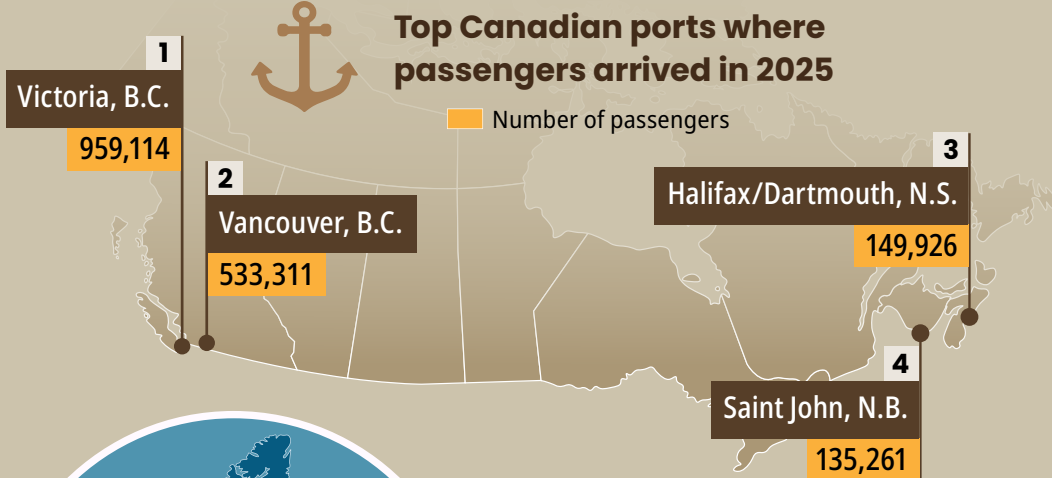


CRUISE SHIP TOURISM IN CANADA, 2025

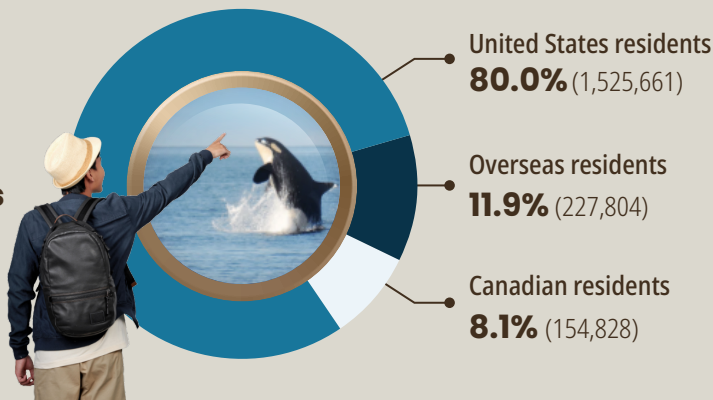

Ports such as Inuvik/Tuktoyaktuk, Pond Inlet and Iqaluit welcomed **5,591** passengers in 2025, up **27.0%** from 2019.
